

# Audubon County Open RWD Rules

1. Safety is our number one concern. Techs have final say on safety concerns and is at their discretion.
2. All cars must be inspected and legal before the drivers meeting
3. Bring all safety equipment with you to tech
4. Drivers in tech area only (for PRE & POST race teching)
5. All drivers must wear full faced helmet, full fire suit, and shoes (gloves recommended)
6. Racing seat mandatory and must be securely fastened on bottom and back of seat No movement if mounted correctly
7. All cars must have 4- or 5-point racing harness
8. All cars must have functioning window net on driver's window
9. Racing fuel cell with rollover valve mandatory with no leaks and must be securely fastened down
10. If fuel line runs through cockpit the line needs to be inside a secured steel conduit that runs from firewall to back decking.
11. All cars must have some type of screen and or at least three ¼" bars on driver's side windshield
12. All cars must have working brakes on driven wheels minimum
13. All cars must have hole in hood or no inner fenders in case of fire
14. All Cars must have 12"x12" two- or three-sided number sign on roof of car and must be clearly visible.
15. All cars must be cleaned out—no trash, junk, or loose debris
16. Must have steel firewall and any holes covers with steel.
17. Must have 4-point cage with a halo minimum.
18. All doors must be welded and or chained shut
19. All hoods/trunks must be pinned shut (no nut/bolt combinations or chains)
20. All wheel weights must be removed
21. All glass, trim, and plastic bumper covers must be removed prior to arriving at the track
22. Any transmission coolers must be secure with no leaks and hoses covered for safety.
23. No profanity or anything inappropriate allowed on cars—this is a family event. Track officials will remove or cover up at driver's expense.
24. Battery must be secured tightly in a battery box and covered. Passenger floorboard is recommended
25. What can you break, even if you never pick it up? You made it this far congrats! Let the pit shack know the answer for a treat.
26. Driveshaft must be painted or taped white and have a loop or X-brace within 6" of front u-joint
27. No convertibles, jeeps, vans, hearses, limos, front wheel drives, el caminos, rancheros, or trucks
28. Driver must notify officials if running alcohol fuel and must have a 6" green letter "A" on pillar behind driver's door
29. Any added weight must be tightly secured and painted white with car number on it.
30. No mirrors of any kind in car
31. No Mud or All Terrain Tires
